Practice skills learned in the InDesign tutorials. You will need:

(About) 2 paragraphs of text; minimum 200 words

- Can be from a book, article, blog, movie dialogue, etc.
- Have citation ready: author, title, publication date.

1 image

- Corresponds to the text in some way
- Should be your own OR free to use (Do **NOT** just grab from Google.)
- Suggested sources: [Pixabay](#), [Unsplash](#), [Pexels](#), [SplitShire](#), [Skitterphoto](#), [StockSnap](#), [Reshot](#), [Gratisography](#), [Picjumbo](#), [KaboomPics](#), [MorgueFile](#)

Create a new 8x8in InDesign document with 2 pages.

Add your text and image to both pages, creating two different compositions.

- Using skills you learned in the tutorial, arrange the type and image in the 8x8 space.
- Design/layout is up to you.
- Use formatting tools to customize text appearance (font, size, color, spacing, etc.).
- Have fun! Clean and simple, loud and crazy; design however pleases you.

Experiment with your layout and style choices until you are satisfied with the 2 compositions.

- Add a citation for the text somewhere on the pages.
>> Keep it small, it does not need to be the same size as main body text. Think along the lines of a caption. Citation style is your choice.

Export to PDF

- **File > Export, then select PDF as your Format.**
- **Make sure “all pages” is selected**
- **Filename: Lastname_TextImage**
